### Annual Check-Up

Yearly check-ups are critical to your dog's overall wellness, leading to longer, healthier, and more active lives. During these appointments, our doctors and technicians will collect a full history and perform a series of examinations and assessments to help prevent disease.

### Vaccinations

Adult dogs need regular vaccines to stay healthy. Our Adult Care Canine Programs include these vaccinations:

- Rabies
- Parvovirus
- Distemper
- Adenovirus
- Leptospirosis
- Bordetella (Kennel Cough)
- Parainfluenza

### Parasite Screening

A fecal exam detects parasites and other intestinal organisms that can cause disease. We then recommend a parasite (dewormer) for your dog to take regularly.

### Preventive Blood Tests

Blood work screens for medical conditions, including diabetes and kidney disease. Early diagnosis and management can improve quality of life. These tests establish normal values which can be compared to see if anything has changed. Our tests include a "CBC" (complete blood count), which can help determine whether your dog is dehydrated, anemic or dealing with an infection. The "comprehensive chemistry" monitors internal organ function (liver, kidneys, pancreas) and the "urinalysis" assesses the health of the kidneys and urinary system and detects diabetes.

### Heartworm and Tick Borne Disease Screening

Heartworm disease is a potentially fatal condition caused by parasitic worms living in the lungs and the heart's blood vessels. A quick and easy lab test determines if a dog is infected with heartworms or has a tick born infection (Lyme disease).

### Dental Cleaning

As tartar builds up, abscesses may form along the gum line causing infection. Left unattended, the infection can enter the blood stream leading to serious health problems such as heart, liver, lung, and kidney disease. Dental cleanings include an examination, X-rays, anesthesia, cleaning and polishing to remove plaque from tooth surfaces.

### Additional Discounts

Depending on the Program selected, you will receive 5% off parasite medications and prescription drugs. Our programs also include a \$5 or \$10 off coupon for purchases in our convenient online store – have your dog's food shipped to your home!

### Payment & Financing Options

We require payment in full of the full cost of the Program upfront. Services are used over the 12 months of the Program. We accept Visa, Mastercard, debit, cash, or e-transfer. We have partnered with Paybright, allowing the cost to be spread out into regular payments for easier budgeting.

### Additional Products and Services

Our regular fees are billed for all products and services not included in the Program. Emergencies, treatment for sickness, surgery, additional laboratory testing, and diagnostic imaging are examples of items not included in the Program. Pet insurance can be purchased to help cover the cost of unexpected sickness and emergencies.

### Canine Senior Healthcare Programs

For dogs age 8 and older, we offer annual Senior Care Programs, which are designed to meet the unique needs of senior dogs, along with discounts on parasite treatment and prescriptions.
