Comprehensive Consultations

Our Kitten Programs include up to 3 wellness consultations performed by our veterinarians. Regular check-ups are critical to your kitten's overall wellness, leading to longer, healthier, and more active lives. During these appointments, our doctors and technicians will answer your questions and provide you with information and tips to make your kitten's first year and beyond as healthy and happy as possible.

Vaccinations

Kittens need several vaccinations to stay healthy. After their first vaccine, kittens need "booster" vaccinations every 3 weeks until they are 16 weeks old. Our Kitten Programs include these vaccinations:

- Rabies
- Feline Leukemia
- FVRCP Combo (rhinotracheitis, calicivirus, and panleukopenia)

Feline Leukemia Test

Feline leukemia is a serious virus. We test to ensure your kitten is not infected and then we provide a feline leukemia vaccine so they cannot become infected.

Parasite Screening

We include up to 3 fecal exams that help us detect parasites and other intestinal organisms that can cause disease. We then recommend a parasiticide (dewormer) for your kitten to take regularly.

Microchip Implantation Procedure

If your pet is lost, their microchip can be scanned to contact you. The permanent microchip is quickly implanted under the skin during a regular office visit or during the spay or neuter.

Spay or Neuter (Healthy Start Plus Programs)

Spays (for females) and neuters (for males) prevent animals from reproducing. Our spay and neuter surgeries include the procedure, pre-surgical bloodwork, anesthesia, IV fluids, pain and nausea medication, and protective e-collar.

Additional Discounts

Receive 5% off parasite medications and prescription drugs. Healthy Start programs also include a \$5 or \$10 off coupon for purchases in our convenient online store – have your pet's food shipped to your home!

Complimentary Virtual Visit

Meet with a veterinarian via phone or video call from the comfort of your home.

Payment & Financing Options

We require payment in full of the full cost of the Program upfront. Services are used over the 12 months of the Program, except for spays/neuters which can be used up to 14 months from the date of purchase. We accept Visa, Mastercard, debit, cash, or e-transfer. We have partnered with Paybright, allowing the cost to be spread out into regular payments for easier budgeting.

Additional Products and Services

Our regular fees are billed for all products and services not included in the Program. Emergencies, treatment for sickness, surgery, additional laboratory testing, and diagnostic imaging are examples of items not included in the Program. Pet insurance can be purchased to help cover the cost of unexpected sickness and emergencies.

Adult Feline Preventive Healthcare Plans

Once your Kitten becomes an adult, we offer annual Adult Care Programs, which include the essential care adults need, along with discounts on parasite treatment and prescriptions.
