

## **Canine Therapeutic Diets – Hypoallergenic & Dermatologic Support**

These veterinary-exclusive diets are formulated to help manage food allergies, intolerances, and skin issues in dogs. Below is a breakdown of each diet, its main protein source, and its primary therapeutic use:

- **HA Hydrolyzed Salmon**

- D/D Salmon  
Use: Same as above  
Key Features: Salmon as a novel protein; grain-free; ideal for elimination diets
- D/D Venison  
Use: Same as above  
Key Features: Venison as a novel protein source; high palatability and skin support
